Summary

- Soft launch of health volunteer program will be in Nowshera today
- A flight will arrive tomorrow early morning containing medical supply/ health unit from Italy
- Leading causes of morbidity are
 - Skin diseases
 - AWD
 - ARI
 - Malaria in Baluchistan/Sindh

Daily consultations

- **157,058** patients got treatment
- Total consultation since 29th July 4.2 million
- 781 fixed and 460 mobile health centers provided data
- Skin diseases -----25,267 (**16%**)
- ARI -----26,716 (**17%**)
- Acute diarrhea -----22,264 (**14%**)
- Suspected malaria -----4,580 (**03%**)
